WORKLESS HOUSEHOLDS 2018

An annual analysis from the Annual Population Survey provides estimates by economic status of:

- Number of households with at least one person aged 16 to 64
- Number of children under 16 in households with at least one person aged 16 to 64

Working households: contains at least one person aged 16 to 64, where all individuals aged 16 and over are in employment

Mixed household: contains at least one person aged 16 to 64, where at least one person aged 16 and over is in employment and at least one other is either unemployed or inactive

Workless household: contains at least one person aged 16 to 64, where no-one aged 16 or over is in employment

As the table below shows:

- In Leeds 63% of households are working, while 14% are workless.
- Leeds has the 2nd highest percentage of working households, but is 4th lowest for workless households.
