

BHR PCN Health Profile - Adults

10.0% have **Diabetes**, compared to **6.9%** in Leeds. This is the **highest of any PCN**.



29.6% Live in **fuel poverty**, compared to **16.0%** in Leeds. This is the **highest of any PCN**.



605.6 per 100,000 is the **Under-75 Mortality Rate**, compared to **388.8** in Leeds.

81.6% live in the **10% most deprived areas**, compared to **25.2%** across Leeds. This is the **highest of any PCN**.

The **most common age band** for men is **30-39** and for women it is **20-29**. This is the same as Leeds.

1.5% have **Severe Mental Health Issues**, compared to **1.1%** in Leeds.



19.2% have **Common Mental Health Issues**, compared to **25.2%** in Leeds.

3.7% have **Coronary Heart Disease**, compared to **3.3%** in Leeds.



3.7% have **Cancer**, below the Leeds rate of **4.6%**.



192.8 per 100,000 is the **Under-75 Cancer Mortality Rate**, compared to **132.6** in Leeds.

679.1 **reported crimes** per 1,000 people per year compared to **167.0** in Leeds. This is the **highest of any PCN**.
